As most of you already know, due to laws, rules and regulations we cannot let people walk around unescorted at the Age of Steam Roundhouse. **FOR SAFETY**, all AoSRH visitors must be in groups of 40 or more people.

There's nothing that we can do about that, *BUT* — short of closing our giant roundhouse doors to everyone — our employees and dedicated volunteers are willing to give up their Saturday days-off to show everyone around.

Since all visitors must be escorted by an AoSRH tour guide, and since it is not practical for each individual or small group to have its own, personal tour guide, we have set the minimum size for tour groups at 40 people.

COME SEE beautifully restored steamers, resplendent in shiny paint and suitable for framed photos for your wall.

COME SEE some beat-up old locomotive hulks that we bought, brought indoors to dry-out and to be restored.

COME SEE a steam locomotive back shop where two steamers are now being rebuilt back to operational status.

COME SEE old freight cars, passenger cars and diesels, as well as all the other things that make railroading fun.

Before arriving at the Age of Steam Roundhouse for your tour, everyone in your group needs to wear proper shoes that cover their entire feet, sign a liability release (sorry, no children under the age of 10), and wear old clothes, as a railroad roundhouse can be a dirty place. There is an admission charge of \$20.00 per person.
